What Does the Resurrection of the Lord Jesus Christ Mean to Me?

- It means eternal life with Jesus Christ - **Colossians 1:14** we (those that are saved by Jesus Christ from eternal damnation) have redemption through His blood, even the forgiveness of sins.
- **John 11:25** ~ Jesus said unto her, I am the resurrection, and the life: he that believeth in me, though he were dead, yet shall he live:

What Does the Resurrection of the Lord Jesus Christ Mean to Me?

- Redemption through Jesus' blood is something I wish everybody had because without it [2 Thessalonians 1:8-9](#) tells us that...them that know not God, and that obey not the gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ: Who shall be punished with everlasting destruction from the presence of the Lord, and from the glory of his power;

What Does the Resurrection of the Lord Jesus Christ Mean to Me?

- Jesus atoned for the sins of all sinners who put their faith and trust in Him with His blood when He voluntarily laid His sinless life down on the cross.
- Jesus conquered death when He victoriously resurrected from His physical death of the cross and is alive forever.

What Does the Resurrection of the Lord Jesus Christ Mean to Me?

Jesus is omnipresent meaning He is in more than one place at one time:

- Jesus is on the throne of grace interceding for His faithful followers right now.
- Romans 8:34 ~ ... [It is] Christ that died, yea rather, that is risen again, who is even at the right hand of God, who also maketh intercession for us.

What Does the Resurrection of the Lord Jesus Christ Mean to Me?

Jesus is omnipresent meaning He is in more than one place at one time:

- Jesus is living in those who people have truly given their hearts to Him.
 - 1 John 4:15 ~ Whosoever shall confess that Jesus is the Son of God, God dwelleth in him, and he in God.
 - Romans 8:14 ~ For as many as are led by the Spirit of God, they are the sons of God.
 - John 15:4 ~ Abide in Me, and I in you. As the branch cannot bear fruit of itself, except it abide in the vine; no more can ye, except ye abide in Me.

What Does the Resurrection of the Lord Jesus Christ Mean to Me?

- Jesus is going to take all the people, who have been saved by His grace, to live with Him forever.
 - John 14:3 ~ And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again, and receive you unto myself; that where I am, there ye may be also.

Jesus Christ of Nazareth is the Only Way to be Saved from Eternal Damnation

- There is no other way or name by which man can be saved other than through the atoning blood and name of Jesus Christ.
- No other person, prophet, name, religion, faith, or any kind of works will save a soul from eternal damnation.
- All people, prophets, and ways, except Jesus Christ, are deceitful lies of Satan our adversary and lead to death.

Jesus Christ of Nazareth is the Only Way to be Saved from Eternal Damnation

- Acts 4:12 ~ Neither is there salvation in any other (than Jesus Christ): for there is none other name under heaven given among men, whereby we must be saved.
- John 14:6 ~ Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by me.
- John 3:15-16 ~ That whosoever believeth in Him (Jesus Christ) should not perish, but have eternal life. For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life.
- 1 Timothy 2:5 ~ For there is one God, and one mediator between God and men, the man Christ Jesus;
- John 3:36 ~ He that believeth on the Son hath everlasting life: and he that believeth not the Son shall not see life; but the wrath of God abideth on him.
- John 8:24 ~ I said therefore unto you, that ye shall die in your sins: for if ye believe not that I am He, ye shall die in your sins.

Why Do We Need a Saviour?

- In the book of Genesis chapters 1 and 2, God tells us the first two people He created were Adam and Eve. After God created them and everything else, He said, in Genesis 1:31 “ it was very good.” This tells us that Adam and Eve were created without sin in them.
- In Genesis 2:17, God commanded Adam not to eat of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil and being the loving, Heavenly Father that God is, He warned Adam that if he disobeyed, he would surely die.
- Now fast forward to Genesis chapter 3 where Satan enters the Garden of Eden as a serpent and tempts Eve to sin which she and Adam both did. As a result, they became unrighteous sinners separated from our righteous and Holy God.

Everyone Is a Sinner Whether They Acknowledge It or Not...

Genesis 3:20 tells us that ... Adam called his wife's name Eve; because she was the mother of all living. Thus, every person who has ever lived, and will ever be born, are descendants of Adam and Eve and are sinners as stated very clearly in the following verses.

○Romans 5:12 ~ Wherefore, as by one man (Adam) sin entered into the world, and death by sin; and so death passed upon all men, for that all have sinned:

○Psalm 51:5 ~ Behold, I was shapen in iniquity; and in sin did my mother conceive me.

○Ecclesiastes 7:20 ~ For [there is] not a just man upon earth, that doeth good, and sinneth not.

○Romans 3:12 ~ For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God;

There is Hope...

- 1 John 1:8-9 ~ If we say that we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us. If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

- The following verse tells us how our sins separate us from God, just like Adam and Eve were separated after they disobeyed God.
 - Isaiah 59:2 ~ But your iniquities have separated between you and your God, and your sins have hid His face from you, that He will not hear.
- Because we are all sinners, we are without question, separated from God now and all through eternity UNLESS JESUS CHRIST KNOWS US AS HIS FOLLOWERS. (Matthew 7:21-23)

In the following verses we see that when we sin, and remember we all do, only the blood of our sinless, resurrected savior, the Lord Jesus Christ, can atone for our sins and thus save our souls.

- Romans 6:23 ~ For the wages of sin [is] death; but the gift of God [is] eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord.
- Leviticus 17:11 ~ ... for it is the blood that maketh an atonement for the soul.
- Hebrews 9:22 ~ ... without shedding of blood is no remission.
- Revelation 1:5 ~ And from Jesus Christ, who is the faithful witness, and the first begotten of the dead, and the prince of the kings of the earth. Unto him that loved us, and washed us from our sins in his own blood,

In the following verses we see that when we sin, and remember we all do, only the blood of our sinless, resurrected savior, the Lord Jesus Christ, can atone for our sins and thus save our souls.

- Romans 5:8-9 ~ But God commendeth his love toward us, in that, while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us. Much more then, being now justified by His blood, we shall be saved from wrath through Him.
- Colossians 1:20 ~ And, having made peace through the blood of His cross, by Him to reconcile all things unto Himself; by Him, I say, whether they be things in earth, or things in heaven.
- Hebrews 9:12 ~ Neither by the blood of goats and calves, but by His own blood He entered in once into the holy place, having obtained eternal redemption for us.

- Romans 5:8 tells us that Christ died for us while we were yet sinners. His shed blood pays the death wage of our sin. His resurrection is the same resurrection power that will resurrect those who have salvation in Him to live throughout eternity with the one true God - our Creator, Savior, and Heavenly Father.
- Romans 1:4 tells us that Jesus Christ is - declared to be the Son of God with power, according to the Spirit of holiness, by the resurrection from the dead:
- Romans 4:25 tells us that Jesus Christ - ... was delivered up because of our offenses, and was raised because of our justification.

Does Jesus Christ have a Relationship with You?

- If you do not have eternal salvation with Jesus Christ, ask Him to save you...
 - Romans 10:9 tells us - That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved.
